“My daughter lives in the community in her own home. She has brain damage from a vehicle accident and has many disabilities, including being legally blind, an L sided hemiplegia and an intellectual disability, she has limited fine motor skills and mobility difficulties. She is now an adult of 42 years.

The nature of her brain injury is that she is not a tolerant person and cannot live with other people. She needs more support than she can afford now and the only way she can get it is if there is another home nearby where people with a disability live and she can access their support staff.

Will the government meet the short fall of money needed to purchase a group home near my daughter's home, where resources can be shared and be cost effective?

My husband and I are ageing and we need to get our daughters needs met now so we can die peacefully one day. I would hope that people with a disability can live in other areas not just the very cheap areas where there are usually many reasons why the land and homes are cheap”
